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Regulations Affecting Licensure

Experience Evaluation—At the direction of the Professional Qualifications Committee Board staff reviewed the Table of Equivalents, (California Code of Regulations (CCR) 117, to identify improvements and reduce delays in licensure. Staff identified architecture related degrees that were not given year-for-year credit and limitations on the maximum amount of credit granted for internships as potential delays.

This proposal would increase the amount of experience allowed for earning a degree related to architecture and broaden the degrees that are related to architecture which will, in turn, reduce delays in licensure. Additionally, increasing the amount of experience that can be granted for completing degree and internship programs will increase efficiencies for staff and reduce unnecessary delays in licensure for candidates.

This proposal was approved and went into effect on January 1, 2025.

Applications—Board staff identified that the application regulation, CCR 109, did not specify pathways for military, asylum, or SkillBridge candidates, and it referenced a National Council of Architectural Registration Boards (NCARB) program that had been changed. Additionally, the forms that were incorporated by reference needed to be updated to reflect the changes to licensure requirements and the Board's change to a new candidate and licensure system.

This proposal specifies the pathway for military, asylum and SkillBridge candidates to have their applications expedited, updates NCARB's internship program from IDP to AXP, and removes the incorporated forms to allow for electronic submittal of examination and licensure applications.

This proposal was approved and went into effect on January 1, 2025.

Reciprocity Requirements—During review of the Board's application regulations, CCR 121 was reviewed and staff identified it referenced programs that no longer existed and pathways that were obsolete. Therefore, a proposal was made to update and simplify this regulation to reflect current requirements to meet reciprocal qualifications.

This proposal removes reference to the Broadly Experienced Foreign Architect pathway to NCARB Certification and the separate instances for foreign NCARB Certificate holders. The revised language simplifies the language to state that the holder of an NCARB Certificate will be eligible for the CSE upon applying with the Board and transmittal of the Certificate.

This proposal was approved and went into effect on April 1, 2025.

New Method for Calculating the License Expiration Date

A recent amendment to California Business and Professions Code (BPC) section 5600 became effective on January 1, 2025. The amendment impacts the date on which an architect license expires and the initial (original) licensure period.

Prior to January 1, 2025, an architect license would expire on the last day of the licensee's birth month in odd-numbered years. This static expiration date would result in a license sometimes being issued at a reduced fee for less than a full two-year cycle and shorten the amount of time available to complete mandatory continuing education.

To improve its processes, CAB sought to have BPC 5600 amended so an architect license issued after January 1, 2025, is valid for a full two-year period that will expire on the last day of the month in which the license was issued. For instance, a license issued on February 12, 2025, will be valid until February 28, 2027. A license issued on March 18, 2026, will now be valid until March 31, 2028.

Architect licenses will now expire in both odd-numbered and even-numbered years (first starting in 2028) and will no longer be linked to the licensee's birth month.

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Mandatory Continuing Education

CAB would like to remind architects that five hours continuing education (CE) on disability access requirements in accordance with California Code of Regulations (CCR) 165 and another five hours on zero-net carbon design in accordance with CCR 166 must be completed prior to the license expiration date for architects renewing timely. Holders of an expired architect license must complete the 10 hours of CE within the preceding two years (24 months) of the date they renew their expired license.

CAB conducts audits of its licensee population to ensure compliance with the mandatory CE requirement. Failure to complete the mandatory CE by the above mentioned deadlines could result in a citation that may include an administrative fine with a maximum monetary penalty ranging between \$1,000 and \$2,500 for each violation in accordance with the criteria set forth in CCR section 152. Consequently, violations of both CCR 165 and 166 could result in an administrative fine up to of \$5,000.

CAB does not have authority to approve providers or coursework or make any recommendations. Providers and coursework that do not meet the requirements specified in CCR 165 and CCR 166 cannot be accepted toward completion of mandatory CE.

Architects are required to retain coursework documentation for two years from the date of renewal. CAB may conduct an audit anytime within the two-year period.

Licensee Emails and Addresses

Licensees are reminded that as of January 1, 2025, a current and valid email address is required to be filed with CAB. The new requirement is in addition to the already existing requirement to maintain a current and valid address of record (AOR) on-file with CAB. Furthermore, licensees must without delay notify CAB of any changes to either their email address or AOR.



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Enforcement Actions

July 2024–February 2025

Final Citations

CHRISTINA R. DANIELS (Napa)—The Board issued a two-count citation with a \$4,000 administrative fine to Christina R. Daniels, an unlicensed person, dba Lone Wolf Designs LLC, for alleged violations of Business and Professions Code sections 5536(a) and 5536.1(c).

Daniels was hired in December 2022 to prepare plans for a home built with concrete forms in Napa County. She was paid \$18,000 after she told her client that she was an architect and stated that the plans would have her “stamp” on them.

Because it involved concrete forms, and not conventional woodframe construction, the project was not exempt from licensing requirements. Daniels’ conduct constituted the practice of architecture as defined in Business and Professions Code section 5500.1 and was therefore a violation of Business and Professions Code section 5536.1(c).

Daniels advertised herself as an architect and architectural designer, using false license numbers. Her company website described her business as a “full service architectural design” firm and offered “architectural design” and “Concrete Builds” under the Services page.

Daniels’ Instagram profile stated she provides “Architectural Design” and displayed posts of plans with “LIC#11038466” in the title block. She also used signage stating “LW Design Architectural Design Lic.# 11038468.”

Daniels’ company LinkedIn profile contained the tagline “Providing Architectural Design.” Her personal LinkedIn profile also described herself as providing “Architectural... design.” Daniels’ claimed company Yelp profile was categorized under “Architects.” Her company Facebook profile offered “Architectural Design Services for Napa County and the Surrounding Bay Area.” Daniels’ Alignable profile offered “full architectural design” and was categorized under “Architectural Designer.” Her Local Yahoo profile was categorized as “Architecture.”

Daniels’ contract, company signage, website, and profiles, wherein she described her services using the terms

“Architect” and “Architectural,” are devices that might indicate to the public that Daniels is an architect or qualified to engage in the practice of architecture in California. Such conduct constitutes violations of Business and Professions Code section 5536(a). Daniels paid the fine, satisfying the citation. The citation became final on October 31, 2024.

DAVID ACOSTA JR. (Van Nuys)—The Board issued a one-count citation with a \$1,500 administrative fine to David Acosta Jr., an unlicensed person, dba Abstract Planning and Design, Inc., and California ADU Center, Inc., for alleged violations of Business and Professions Code section 5536(a) and Title 16, California Code of Regulations section 134(a).

On or about March 3, 2022, Acosta, doing business as “Abstract Planning and Design, Inc.,” signed a contract with Mr. J.W. (client) to provide services for a project located on Magnolia Boulevard in North Hollywood. He agreed to assist with the nonstructural change of use of the existing building from a studio to a church with the approval from the Los Angeles Department of Building and Safety (LADBS) for a fixed fee of \$5,700. This contract includes an “architectural drafting set.” Respondent has been paid \$4,650 but has failed to complete the project.

Acosta’s company Facebook profile, dba California ADU Center, Inc., was categorized under “Architectural Designer.” His company Instagram profiles, dba California ADU Center, Inc., used the title of “Architectural Designer” and offered “Architects” and “Architecture.” His company Yelp profile, dba California ADU Center, Inc., was categorized under “Architects.” His company Yelp profile, dba Abstract Planning & Design, Inc., offered “architectural plans.”

Acosta failed to respond to the Board’s request for a response and corrections.

Acosta’s contract and online profiles, wherein he described his services as “Architectural” and “Architecture” and offered an “Architect,” are devices that might indicate to the public that he is an architect or qualified to engage in the practice of architecture in California. Such conduct constitutes violations of Business and Professions Code section 5536(a) and Title 16, California Code of Regulations section 134(a). This citation became final on November 23, 2024.

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EDDY LIU (Chandler, AZ)—The Board issued a one-count citation with a \$1,000 administrative fine to Eddy Liu, an unlicensed person, dba Archi Partners Design, for alleged violations of Business and Professions Code section 5536(a).

On and between December 6, 2023, through March 12, 2024, Liu represented himself as an architect and his company as an architectural firm through the following advertisements: Liu's company website and business name use the word "Archi." Liu's company Facebook profile indicates that he provides services in architecture. In Liu's LinkedIn profile he calls himself an "Architect and Contractor" in his job title and experience, and states that he provides "Architectural Outsourcing Services."

Liu's online advertising and profiles are devices that might indicate to the public that he is an architect or qualified to engage in the practice of architecture in California. Such conduct constitutes a violation of Business and Professions Code section 5536(a). This citation became final on October 28, 2024.

BRYAN THOMAS MURPHY (Santa Barbara)—The Board issued a two-count citation with a \$750 administrative fine to Bryan Thomas Murphy, a licensed architect, license number C-15694, for alleged violations of Business and Professions Code sections 5582.1(a) and 5536.22(a).

On or about June 6, 2017, a landscape architect (Mr. K.S.) was hired by DP Investments to design landscape plans for a multi-family development called the Posada Del Sol located in Santa Maria. Mr. K.S. created plans for the project, but the project stalled out after receiving plan check comments from the city. Mr. K.S. then terminated his contract with the client on or about April 7, 2022, and abandoned the project after being paid in full for his work. After Mr. K.S.'s termination of the contract, Murphy was asked by the client to take over responsibility for finishing the project. Murphy did not execute a written contract for these services with the client.

Murphy informed the client that he would need to fully review Mr. K.S.'s drawings, check for health and safety concerns, and make any changes he deemed necessary. Murphy charged the client an hourly rate for these services. However, Murphy stated that "due to time constraints" he had not redrawn the plans or made any design or detail changes to the landscape plans prepared by Mr. K.S. prior to him signing and stamping them, and submitting them to the city.

Murphy appeared to modify Mr. K.S.'s drawings by simply changing the contact information on the cover sheet, adding his information to the title block for all sheets, and stamping and signing the drawings. Plans for the project that Murphy submitted to the city still contained Mr. K.S.'s phone number in the contact list, and still contained Mr. K.S.'s initials and his drafter's initials.

On or about October 21, 2022, the city returned the plans to the respondent along with 19 pages of corrections. Murphy subsequently had to "dramatically revise" Mr. K.S.'s plans as they contained numerous errors and omissions that needed to be corrected. The Board was provided with what appeared to be original plans created by the Murphy on his own title block.

Murphy signing and stamping plans that he did not prepare and which were not prepared under his immediate and responsible direction, constitutes a violation of Business and Professions Code section 5582.1(a). Murphy's failure to execute a written contract with the client prior to commencing professional services for the above-referenced project constitutes a violation of Business and Professions Code section 5536.22(a). Murphy paid the fine satisfying the citation. The citation became final on December 4, 2024.

FRANCO RICALDE (Van Nuys)—The Board issued a one-count citation with a \$750 administrative fine to Franco Ricalde, an unlicensed person, dba RR Architectural Design, for alleged violations of Business and Professions Code section 5536(a) and California Code of Regulations section 134(a).

On or about February 12, 2024, the Board received a complaint alleging possible violations of the Architects Practice Act regarding a residential project located in Castaic. Ricalde, doing business as RR Architectural Design, had designed the project and included the term "architect" on his title block.

Ricalde's company website uses the business name RR Architectural Design and states, "Enjoy our unique architectural solution and design projects!," "Designing sustainable, high-performance (projects) requires an integration of architectural and engineered systems into a balanced design of sustainability..." "We are here to meet your demand and resolve architecture issues the most beneficial way for you," and "RR Architectural Design is the leader of providing architect services and implementing ideas!"

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Ricalde's company Home Advisor profile is categorized under architectural design companies and states, "We are a reputable architectural design company" and "I chose to work in this industry because Design and architecture is my passion..." and includes architect under Areas of Expertise.

Ricalde's company Yelp profile is categorized under Architects and states, "Our business specializes on architectural design elaborating plans, 3d models and get permits from the city."

Ricalde's company MapQuest profile states, "RR Architectural Design is a leading architectural firm based in Van Nuys, CA" and "RR Architectural Design integrates architectural and engineered systems into a balanced design of sustainability and cost-effectiveness."

Ricalde failed to respond to the Board's request for a response and corrections.

Ricalde's business name, title block, website, and online profiles wherein he used the title of "Architect" and described his services as "Architectural" and "Architecture" are devices that might indicate to the public that Ricalde is an architect or qualified to engage in the practice of architecture in California. Such conduct constitutes violations of Business and Professions Code section 5536(a) and Title 16, California Code of Regulations section 134(a). This citation became final on November 16, 2024.

SHERRY YAN SHI (Diamond)—The Board issued a one-count citation with a \$1,500 administrative fine to Sherry Yan Shi, an unlicensed person, dba YS Design & Associates, Inc., for alleged violations of Business and Professions Code section 5536(a).

On or about July 23, 2023, Shi, doing business as YS Design & Associates, Inc., signed a design agreement with Mr. K.W. (client) to design a single-family house addition for the project located on Frankmont Street in El Monte for a fixed fee of \$5,800. Shi has been paid \$2,800. The agreement included "Architect design" and "Architect final drawing."

Shi's LinkedIn profile offers "Architectural/Interior Design" and states, "Architectural design for house remodel, addition and new house design."

Shi's contract and LinkedIn profile wherein she described herself as an "Architect" and offered "Architectural" services, are devices that might indicate to the public that she is an architect or qualified to engage in the practice of architecture in California. Such conduct constitutes violations of Business and Professions Code section 5536(a). This citation became final on December 7, 2024.

Final Citations

Stephen Antonaros (San Francisco)—The Board issued a one-count citation that included a \$750 administrative fine to Stephen Antonaros, architect license number C-14386, for an alleged violation of Business and Professions Code section 5600.05(a)(1) (License Renewal Process; Conditions; Certifications; Audit; False or Misleading Information; Disciplinary Action; Coursework Regarding Disability Access Requirements and Zero Net Carbon Design; Submission of Letter to Legislature). The action alleged that Antonaros certified false or misleading information on their 2023 License Renewal Application. Antonaros paid the fine, satisfying the citation. The citation became final on October 1, 2024.

Leslie Wynne Lebon (Troy)—The Board issued a one-count citation that included a \$250 administrative fine to Leslie Wynne Lebon, architect license number C-24832, for an alleged violation of Business and Professions Code section 5600.05(a)(1) (License Renewal Process; Conditions; Certifications; Audit; False or Misleading Information; Disciplinary Action; Coursework Regarding Zero Net Carbon Design; Submission of Letter to Legislature). The action alleged that Lebon certified false or misleading information on their 2023 License Renewal Application. Lebon paid the fine, satisfying the citation. The citation became final on October 2, 2024.

Nathan Lee Colkitt (Jacksonville, WY)—The Board issued a one-count citation that included a \$1,000 administrative fine to Nathan Lee Colkitt, architect license number C-30724, for an alleged violation of Business and Professions Code section 5600.05(a)(1) (License Renewal Process; Conditions; Certifications; Audit; False or Misleading Information; Disciplinary Action; Coursework Regarding Disability Access Requirements and Zero Net Carbon Design; Submission of Letter to Legislature). The action alleged that Colkitt certified false or misleading information on their 2023 license renewal application. The citation became final on October 11, 2024.

Douglas Dorman Joyce (Pasadena)—The Board issued a one-count citation that included a \$500 administrative fine to Douglas Dorman Joyce, architect license number C-20132, for an alleged violation of Business and

Professions Code section 5600.05(a)(1) (License Renewal Process; Conditions; Certifications; Audit; False or Misleading Information; Disciplinary Action; Coursework Regarding Disability Access Requirements; Submission of Letter to Legislature). The action alleged that Joyce certified false or misleading information on their 2023 license renewal application. The citation became final on October 11, 2024.

Jessica M. Schmitzberger (Los Angeles)—The Board issued a one-count citation that included a \$500 administrative fine to Jessica M. Schmitzberger, architect license number C-35530, for an alleged violation of Business and Professions Code section 5600.05(a)(1) (License Renewal Process; Conditions; Certifications; Audit; False or Misleading Information; Disciplinary Action; Coursework Regarding Zero Net Carbon Design; Submission of Letter to Legislature). The action alleged that Schmitzberger certified false or misleading information on their 2023 license renewal application. Schmitzberger paid the fine, satisfying the citation. The citation became final on October 11, 2024.

Audrey V. Stratton (San Diego)—The Board issued a one-count citation that included a \$1,000 administrative fine to Audrey V. Stratton, architect license number C-28089, for an alleged violation of Business and Professions Code section 5600.05(a)(1) (License Renewal Process; Conditions; Certifications; Audit; False or Misleading Information; Disciplinary Action; Coursework Regarding Disability Access Requirements and Zero Net Carbon Design; Submission of Letter to Legislature). The action alleged that Stratton certified false or misleading information on their 2023 license renewal application. Stratton paid the fine, satisfying the citation. The citation became final on October 11, 2024.

Luciana Vidal (Los Angeles)—The Board issued a one-count citation that included a \$250 administrative fine to Luciana Vidal, architect license number C-36141, for an alleged violation of Business and Professions Code section 5600.05(a)(1) (License Renewal Process; Conditions; Certifications; Audit; False or Misleading Information; Disciplinary Action; Coursework Regarding Disability Access Requirements and Zero Net Carbon Design; Submission of

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Letter to Legislature). The action alleged that Vidal certified false or misleading information on their 2023 license renewal application. Vidal paid the fine, satisfying the citation. The citation became final on October 12, 2024.

Kevin Michael Wilkeson (Orange)—The Board issued a one-count citation that included a \$500 administrative fine to Kevin Michael Wilkeson, architect license number C-20601, for an alleged violation of Business and Professions Code section 5600.05(a)(1) (License Renewal Process; Conditions; Certifications; Audit; False or Misleading Information; Disciplinary Action; Coursework Regarding Disability Access Requirements; Submission of Letter to Legislature). The action alleged that Wilkeson certified false or misleading information on their 2023 license renewal application. Wilkeson paid the fine, satisfying the citation. The citation became final on October 21, 2024.

Tod R. Curtis (San Francisco)—The Board issued a one-count citation that included a \$500 administrative fine to Tod R. Curtis, architect license number C-26541, for an alleged violation of Business and Professions Code section 5600.05(a)(1) (License Renewal Process; Conditions; Certifications; Audit; False or Misleading Information; Disciplinary Action; Coursework Regarding Disability Access Requirements; Submission of Letter to Legislature). The action alleged that Curtis certified false or misleading information on their 2023 license renewal application. Curtis paid the fine, satisfying the citation. The citation became final on November 9, 2024.

David M. Ellis (Santa Monica)—The Board issued a one-count citation that included a \$750 administrative fine to David M. Ellis, architect license number C-25514, for an alleged violation of Business and Professions Code section 5600.05(a)(1) (License Renewal Process; Conditions; Certifications; Audit; False or Misleading Information; Disciplinary Action; Coursework Regarding Disability Access Requirements and Zero Net Carbon Design; Submission of Letter to Legislature). The action alleged that Ellis certified false or misleading information on their 2023 license renewal application. Ellis paid the fine, satisfying the citation. The citation became final on November 14, 2024.

Domenic Henry Silvestri (Los Angeles)—The Board issued a one-count citation that included a \$250 administrative fine to Domenic Henry Silvestri, architect license number C-23716, for an alleged violation of Business and Professions Code section 5600.05(a)(1) (License Renewal Process; Conditions; Certifications; Audit; False or

Misleading Information; Disciplinary Action; Coursework Regarding Disability Access Requirements and Zero Net Carbon Design; Submission of Letter to Legislature). The action alleged that Silvestri certified false or misleading information on their 2023 license renewal application. Silvestri paid the fine, satisfying the citation. The citation became final on November 15, 2024.

Stephen M. Albert (Santa Monica) — The Board issued a one-count citation that included a \$500 administrative fine to Stephen M. Albert, architect license number C-9412, for an alleged violation of Business and Professions Code section 5600.05(a)(1) (License Renewal Process; Conditions; Certifications; Audit; False or Misleading Information; Disciplinary Action; Coursework Regarding Disability Access Requirements and Zero Net Carbon Design; Submission of Letter to Legislature). The action alleged that Albert certified false or misleading information on their 2023 license renewal application. Albert paid the fine, satisfying the citation. The citation became final on November 15, 2024.

Jane Ann Lehman (San Francisco)—The Board issued a one-count citation that included a \$350 administrative fine to Jane Ann Lehman, architect license number C-25035, for an alleged violation of Business and Professions Code section 5600.05(a)(1) (License Renewal Process; Conditions; Certifications; Audit; False or Misleading Information; Disciplinary Action; Coursework Regarding Disability Access Requirements; Submission of Letter to Legislature). The action alleged that Lehman certified false or misleading information on their 2023 license renewal application. Lehman paid the fine, satisfying the citation. The citation became final on November 18, 2024.

Patrick Fox (Solon, OH)—The Board issued a one-count citation that included a \$750 administrative fine to Patrick Fox, architect license number C-38155, for an alleged violation of Business and Professions Code section 5600.05(a)(1) (License Renewal Process; Conditions; Certifications; Audit; False or Misleading Information; Disciplinary Action; Coursework Regarding Zero Net Carbon Design; Submission of Letter to Legislature). The action alleged that Fox certified false or misleading information on their 2023 license renewal application. Fox paid the fine, satisfying the citation. The citation became final on November 23, 2024.

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Ignatius Siu Kong Tsang (Greenbrae)—The Board issued a one-count citation that included a \$500 administrative fine to Ignatius Siu Kong Tsang, architect license number C-13096, for an alleged violation of Business and Professions Code section 5600.05(a)(1) (License Renewal Process; Conditions; Certifications; Audit; False or Misleading Information; Disciplinary Action; Coursework Regarding Disability Access Requirements and Zero Net Carbon Design; Submission of Letter to Legislature). The action alleged that Tsang certified false or misleading information on their 2023 license renewal application. Tsang paid the fine, satisfying the citation. The citation became final on November 25, 2024.

Kevin L. Callahan (Scottsdale, AZ)—The Board issued a one-count citation that included a \$500 administrative fine to Kevin L. Callahan, architect license number C-28244, for an alleged violation of Business and Professions Code section 5600.05(a)(1) (License Renewal Process; Conditions; Certifications; Audit; False or Misleading Information; Disciplinary Action; Coursework Regarding Disability Access Requirements and Zero Net Carbon Design; Submission of Letter to Legislature). The action alleged that Callahan certified false or misleading information on their 2023 license renewal application. Callahan paid the fine, satisfying the citation. The citation became final on November 25, 2024.

J. Ben Regalado (Orange)—The Board issued a one-count citation that included a \$500 administrative fine to J. Ben Regalado, architect license number C-32791, for an alleged violation of Business and Professions Code section 5600.05(a)(1) (License Renewal Process; Conditions; Certifications; Audit; False or Misleading Information; Disciplinary Action; Coursework Regarding Zero Net Carbon Design; Submission of Letter to Legislature). The action alleged that Regalado certified false or misleading information on their 2023 license renewal application. Regalado paid the fine, satisfying the citation. The citation became final on November 29, 2024.
