Consumer Alert Regarding Freelancing Websites

When seeking professional architectural services online, please keep in mind that many freelancing platforms can allow anyone to advertise their services but may not verify if they are properly licensed.

Engaging an unlicensed provider for residential projects exposes both you and your property to significant risk. Improperly-drafted plans can result in costly construction mistakes, hazardous conditions, non-compliance with local permitting requirements, and potential civil liability.

Make sure to check the license before starting your project! You can verify a person's license online using the California Department of Consumer Affairs' License Search tool at <https://search.dca.ca.gov/>.

Regulations Affecting Licensure

Retired License – Staff identified scenarios where licensees were returning their retired licenses to active status after short periods of time. This was not the intent of the retired license. Staff proposed that the retired license cannot be returned to active until at least one year has passed. Additionally, this proposal requires the licensee provide proof of continuing education (CE) completion when returning to an active status so the licensee is current on CE requirements.

This regulatory proposal was approved and became effective July 1, 2026.

Review of Applications – During review of the Board's regulations, staff identified the processing times in CCR 111 were antiquated and needed updating to reflect current practices. The proposal updates language to current practice and adds processing times for retired licenses.

This regulatory proposal was approved and will become effective October 1, 2026.

Delegation of Certain Functions – During review of the Board's regulations, staff identified a potential issue of enforcement-related delays should the Board not have an executive officer. This proposal will clarify that, in the absence of the executive officer, the delegated enforcement authority will extend to the assistant executive officer. The authority will be conferred to an interim or acting executive officer when the Board selects one.

This regulatory proposal was approved and will become effective October 1, 2026.

Architect-in-Training – Assembly Bill (AB) 759 (Valencia, Chapter 380, Statutes of 2025) established the Architect-in-Training (AIT) title and the Board's authority to charge an AIT application fee. Candidates must have passed at least one division of the Architect Registration Examination (ARE) within the past four years, identify a supervising architect, and pay a fee to apply for the title. The title does not confer any additional practice authority and is optional for candidates.

This is currently in the public comment period, which ends August 24, 2026.

PAPERLESS LICENSURE

For the past few years, CAB has been moving forward on its journey toward a paperless licensure future. In January 2025, CAB transitioned to online license renewals, opening the door for architects to use forms of payment previously not allowed, such as credit and debit cards. Online renewals are also immediate. No more waiting weeks for a renewal application to be processed. More than 15,000 architects renewed their license online during the last renewal cycle. Unfortunately, architects whose license is expired for more than one renewal cycle (two or more years) must **contact our office** for assistance on renewing their license.

On July 1, 2026, CAB discontinued the printing of paper wall and pocket licenses. However, it will continue to print the decorative wall certificates mailed to architects when they initially receive a California architect license.

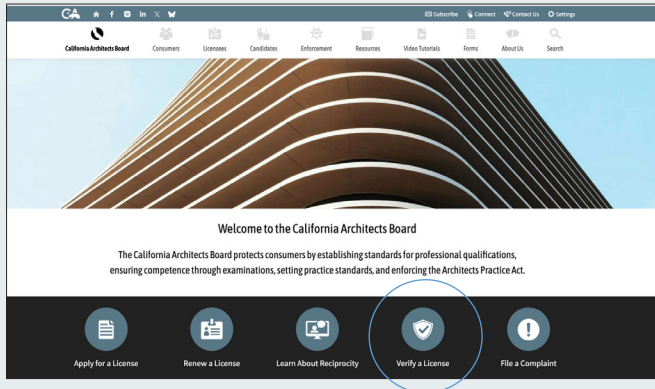
Also, just like during the latter half of the 2025 to 2027 renewal cycle, CAB will no longer be mailing the traditional 8.5"x14" renewal notices. Instead, a smaller standard-sized renewal reminder postcard will be sent to architects advising them of the need to renew with directions to use the online portal, Connect, to submit a renewal application.

Lastly, CAB will no longer be mailing renewal license documentation to architects. Instead, architects can access their license information using the following process:

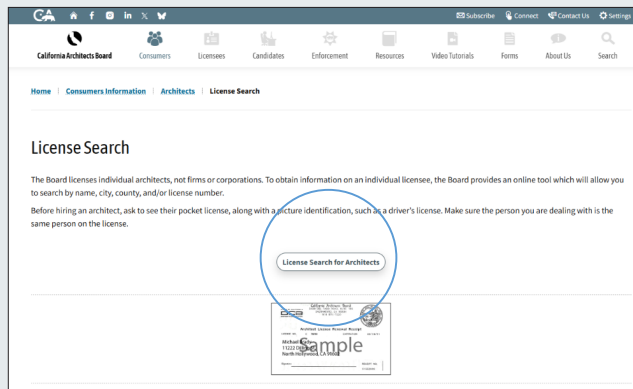
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1. Click on the "Verify a License" icon on the CAB website homepage (see circled icon below).

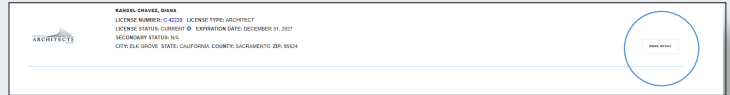


2. Click on the "License Search for Architects" button (circled).

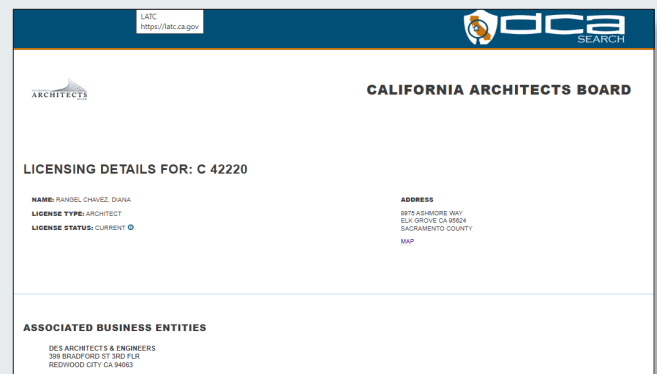


3. Select "Architect" or "Temp-Architect" from the dropdown list in the "License Type" field and then either enter your license number (without the "C" prefix) in the corresponding field or enter your first and last names in the corresponding field. Click the "Search" button after the above information is entered.

4. The following screen with your respective information will appear.



5. Click the "More Detail" button as shown circled above and it will take you to the below screen. The screen will also list all business entities you are associated with, and your listing on the Business Entity Reporting Form (BERF). Architects are required to file a separate BERF for each business to which they offer services.



6. You may print the above screen.

Printing out this page meets the requirements of California Code of Regulations (CCR) §140, requiring architects to provide notice to their client that they are currently licensed by CAB. CCR 140 also lists other methods for compliance.

2027 License Renewals

This November, architects will again renew their licenses. CAB transitioned its license renewals to the application portal, **Connect**. More than 15,000 architects created a Connect account and renewed their license online during the last renewal cycle.

Architects who did not renew online during the last renewal cycle must register a Connect account and link their license to renew it. Licensees are ineligible to renew online if their license is expired for more than one renewal cycle (two or more years) and must **contact CAB** for assistance.

Registering a Connect Account

Register a Connect account by selecting the “Click here to Register” link located directly below the “Log In” button (see below). This will start the process for creating a Connect profile.

It is important to verify all the personal information in the architect's profile, including email address, name, date of birth, and the last four of the Social Security Number. Incorrect personal information entered when registering the account will cause errors when an architect attempts to link and renew their license. These errors must be corrected by CAB and may cause delays with the license renewal process that could potentially result in license expiration and a delinquency fee.

Architects will receive an email with a temporary password upon successful registration of a Connect account.

Renewal Process

Architects start the renewal process by logging into their Connect account and entering the email address used to register the account in the “User Name (Email)” field. There will be a prompt to change the temporary password if this is the first time logging into Connect.

Next, an architect must link their existing architect license to their Connect account by clicking the green “License Link” button located above the Actions column of the Licenses block of the dashboard (see below).

After clicking the “License Link” button, select the license type from the dropdown list in the new input window. Next, enter their license number **omitting the preceding “C.”**

Then click “Submit.” If an error message is received, please contact CAB at **cab-connect@dca.ca.gov**. Please be sure to include your full name, license number, and a screenshot of the error in the email.

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A licensee will receive the following message upon successfully linking their license.

An architect's license information should now appear in the licenses block on the user dashboard. If an architect is **within 90 days of their license expiration date**, the option to "Renew License" should be available under the "Actions" column. Select this option to be directed to the renewal application.

The renewal application consists of several tabs located on the left-hand side of the window. The tabs are:

- Instructions and Disclosures
- Personal Information
- Renewal Questions
- Attestation
- Fee and Payment

Complete each application tab, **making sure to select the option to "Save and Continue" at the bottom of each tab**. You will be automatically directed to the next tab, and the previous tab should now display a green check mark indicating it is completed.

Architects on the "Renewal Questions" tab must confirm they have completed the mandatory 10 hours of continuing education (CE) and upload documentation verifying completion. The mandatory CE consists of five hours on disability access requirements (ADA) and another five hours on zero net carbon design (ZNCD) as required per **BPC Section 5600.05** and California Code of Regulations sections **165** and **166**.

The checkbox next to the declaration on the Attestation tab must be checked and then the **full legal name** must be typed in the "Signature" field. The date cannot be edited and is set to the date you are completing the application. Select "Save and Continue."

The final step in the process is completion of the Fee and Payment tab. On this tab, an architect will enter the information for their preferred payment (**we only accept Visa, Mastercard, or Discover**) and enter their billing information. Select the option to "Copy Details from Application" if the billing information is the same as the address on the application. The billing address does not need to match an address of record. The button to "Pay and Submit" should now be green and selectable.

Click the option to "Pay and Submit." **Click the button only one time and do not refresh the page.** Otherwise, there may be duplicate payments. The status in the Applications block of the dashboard should say "Approved," and the Licenses block of the dashboard will now reflect an updated expiration date (see below). An architect will also receive email and/or text notification that the license has been successfully renewed.

Enforcement Actions

November 2025–June 2026

Final Citations

ANGELINA OLEGOVNA GORBASEVA (Los Angeles)

- The Board issued a one-count citation with a \$1,500 administrative fine to Angelina Olegovna Gorbaseva, an unlicensed person, dba Polymath Development Group Inc., for alleged violations of Business and Professions Code sections 5536(a) and California Code of Regulations section 134(a).

On or around July 2, 2022, Gorbaseva entered into a contract with Ms. I.M. (client) to design a new detached 800-square-foot accessory dwelling unit (ADU) in Orange with two bedrooms, two bathrooms, a kitchen, laundry, and living room for a fixed fee of \$10,000. The contract's scope of work included "ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN" and "Prepare an architectural design." Gorbaseva has been paid \$10,037 and has failed to respond to her client since April 19, 2024.

The design plans included the name and signature of an "Architectural Designer" in the title block.

Gorbaseva's contract and plans, wherein Gorbaseva included the title of "Architectural Designer" and described her services as "Architectural," are devices that might indicate to the public that she is an architect or qualified to engage in the practice of architecture in California. Such conduct constitutes violations of Business and Professions Code section 5536(a) and title 16, California Code of Regulations section 134(a). The citation became final on December 20, 2025.

MATT CARTER (Woodland Hills) - The Board issued a two-count citation with a \$3,000 administrative fine to Matt Carter, an unlicensed person, dba ArchiOven LLC, for alleged violations of Business and Professions Code sections 5536(a) and California Code of Regulations section 134(a).

On or about July 19, 2025, the Board received a complaint alleging Carter agreed to design a one-story addition and remodel for an existing home in Westlake Village. The contract's scope of work included "Architectural As-Builts" and "Architectural Plans" for a fixed rate of \$6,284.40, of which \$5,655.96 was paid. The clients have been unable to reach Carter via email, text, or phone since June 19, 2025.

Carter's email signature block included the business name ArchiOven, the title of "Architectural Designer," and used the email domain: @archioven.com. The title block and Project Team sections of the project plans dated January 31, 2025, included the term "Architectural Design."

Carter's Yelp profile was categorized under "Architects," offered "Architectural design," "Architectural site analysis," and "Architectural project management," and stated, "We here at ArchivOven [sic] with our 13+ years of experience in the field. Can help you with all your Architectural and [sic] Permitting needs."

Carter's company Houzz profile was categorized under "Architects" and offered "Architectural Design" and "Architectural Drawings." Carter was listed as an "Architectural Designer" on Facebook.

Carter's business name, contract, email address, title block, and online profiles (Facebook/Houzz/Yelp), wherein he used the title of "Architectural Designer," described his services as "Architectural" and "Architecture," and categorized his company under "Architects" are devices that might indicate to the public that he is an architect or qualified to engage in the practice of architecture in California. Such conduct constitutes violations of Business and Professions Code section 5536(a) and title 16, California Code of Regulations section 134(a). The citation became final January 18, 2026.

FRANCISCO VEGA (Bakersfield) - The Board issued a two-count citation with a \$3,000 administrative fine to Francisco Vega, an unlicensed person, dba FVC Architecture Design, for alleged violations of Business and Professions Code sections 5536(a) and California Code of Regulations section 134(a).

On or about February 12, 2024, the Board received a complaint alleging Vega, doing business as FVC Architectural Design, entered into a contract to provide design services for a restaurant tenant improvement project located in Bakersfield for a fixed fee of \$13,000. Vega accepted full payment, then failed to deliver the services he agreed to provide, thereby causing financial harm and project delays.

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Vega's contract offered "Architectural drawings," and used the title of "Architectural Designer." The contract stated, "All drawings to be wet stamped or electronically signed by a registered California Architect or Engineer."

Vega's business name and contract, wherein he used the business name of "FVC Architectural Design," used the title of "Architectural Designer," and described his services as "Architectural," are devices that might indicate to the public that Vega is an architect or qualified to engage in the practice of architecture in California. Such conduct constitutes violations of Business and Professions Code section 5536(a) and title 16, California Code of Regulations section 134(a). The citation became final March 13, 2026.

ARUN BIESSAR (Elk Grove) - The Board issued a one-count citation with a \$1,500 administrative fine to Arun Biessar, an unlicensed person, dba AKB Builders, for alleged violations of Business and Professions Code sections 5536(a) and California Code of Regulations section 134(a).

On or about April 14, 2025, the Board received a complaint alleging Biessar, doing business as AKB Builders, had been hired to provide design and drafting services for an accessory dwelling unit (ADU) in Daly City for a fixed fee of \$5,000. Biessar has been paid \$4,500, but there are outstanding corrections pending with the building department. The client made multiple attempts to reach Biessar via phone and text message over the last six months, but Biessar failed to respond to those requests for information.

The contract proposal offered "Architectural design and drafting," and Biessar's personal LinkedIn profile used the title of "Architect."

The Board sent letters to Biessar on June 18, 2025, and August 7, 2025, requesting corrections. USPS tracking confirmed delivery, but no reply was received.

Biessar's contract proposal and personal LinkedIn profile, wherein Biessar used the title of "Architect" and described his services as "Architectural," are devices that might indicate to the public that Biessar is an architect or qualified to engage in the practice of architecture in California. Such conduct constitutes violations of Business and Professions Code section 5536(a) and Title 16, California Code of Regulations section 134(a). The citation became final on March 19, 2026.

CAROLINE STEELE (Riverside) - The Board issued a citation with a \$1,500 administrative fine to Caroline Steele, an unlicensed person, dba BimCad Drafting, for alleged violations of Business and Professions Code sections 5536(a) and California Code of Regulations section 134(a).

On or about July 16, 2025, the Board received a complaint alleging Steele, dba BimCad Drafting, was hired to produce approved plans for a wooden deck replacement destroyed by a 2023 winter storm in Crestline. Steele described herself as an architect and offered "architectural" and "architecture services." She was paid \$6,000, but failed to provide the services agreed to.

Steele's company website stated, "We provide Drafting Services for a multitude of Industries ranging from Architectural to Product Design... We hold backgrounds in design from Product to Architecture and Civil." The website also stated: "We use Sketchup for architectural models."

Steele's claimed company Yelp profile was categorized under "Architects," offered "Architectural design" and "Architectural project management" services and stated, "We Specialize in Architectural design."

Steele's company Mapquest profile stated, "BIMCAD Drafting Services, located in Riverside, CA, offers a comprehensive range of drafting services for various industries, including architectural and product design. Their team is certified in industry-leading software and combines expertise in design, architecture, and civil engineering to efficiently manage projects from initial brainstorming to final illustrations."

Steele included a stamp on the project plans dated January 17, 2024, that was similar to an architect's stamp. The stamp was circular and similar in size to an architect stamp and included the company name "BIM CAD" and a line for their signature and date. In California, "drafter" is not a state-licensed profession, so there is no official state-issued stamp. Only licensed professionals, such as architects and engineers, are required to use a stamp or seal on documents to certify their work. When a stamp is required, drafters typically work under the supervision of a licensed professional, who then signs and stamps the final plans.

On October 15, 2025, the Board asked Steele for a copy of her contract and documentation of revisions to her website and online profiles. A response to this request was not received.

Steele's website and online profiles wherein her business was categorized under "Architects," and she described her

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services as "Architecture" and "Architectural," are devices that might indicate to the public that Steele is an architect or qualified to engage in the practice of architecture in California. Such conduct constitutes violations of Business and Professions Code section 5536(a) and title 16, California Code of Regulations section 134(a). The citation became final March 26, 2026.

GUSTAVE CARLSON (Berkeley) - The Board issued a three-count citation with a \$7,500 administrative fine to Gustave Carlson, an unlicensed person, dba Gustave Carlson Design, for alleged violations of Business and Professions Code sections 5536(a) and California Code of Regulations section 134(a).

Carlson was previously issued a citation #23-05 on February 23, 2023, for violations of Business and Professions Code (BPC) section 5536(a) and California Code of Regulations (CCR) sections 134(a) and 134(b). Carlson failed to revise his online content but paid the \$4,000 fine.

On or about September 12, 2024, the Board opened a new complaint alleging Carlson continued to represent himself as an architect and was still offering architectural services through his company Gustave Carlson Design.

Carlson's company website, LinkedIn, Instagram, YouTube, Arch Daily, Arch Eyes and Houzz profiles referred to him as an "Architect" or described his services as "Architecture" and "Architectural."

Articles in *Aspire* magazine, *California Home + Design*, *Global Design News*, *Sunset Magazine*, *V2 Com Newswire*, and Carlson's book, *Pacific Modern: Houses of Northern California* referred to him as an "Architect" or described his services as "Architecture" and "Architectural."

Carlson's online profiles, articles and publications wherein he used the title of "Architect" and described his services as "architectural" and "architecture" are devices that might indicate to the public that Carlson is an architect or qualified to engage in the practice of architecture in California. Such conduct constitutes violations of BPC section 5536(a) and Title 16, CCR section 134(a).

Carlson's advertising violations were egregious and numerous, demonstrating a disregard for the law and willful violations of the Act. Despite a previous Order of Abatement, Carlson did not correct most of the violations from his online presence even after being informed of them by the Board. Carlson has a history of violations and continues to violate the Act by advertising and misrepresenting himself as an architect.

Carlson failed to cooperate with the Board's investigation and did not reply to the Board's multiple requests for a response to the allegations and to bring his advertising into compliance. The citation became final April 6, 2025.

Disciplinary Action

Maxwell Anthony Beaumont (Emeryville) - Effective April 27, 2026, Maxwell Anthony Beaumont's Architect License No. C-24621 was revoked. However, the revocation was stayed, and he was placed on probation for five years with specific terms and conditions, including reimbursing the Board for \$9,178.50 for investigative costs and his client \$4,000 for restitution.

An accusation filed against Beaumont alleged six causes for discipline for violations of: (1) Business and Professions Code (BPC) section 5584 (Negligence or Willful Misconduct); (2) BPC section 5536.22(a)(5), (7), and (8) (Written Contract Requirements); (3) California Code of Regulations (CCR), title 16, section 160(c)(1) (Failure to Respond to the Board); (4) BPC section 5584 and CCR, title 16, section 150 (Negligence or Willful Misconduct); (5) BPC section 5536.22 (a)(5), (7), and (8) (Written Contract Requirements); (6) BPC section 125.9(b)(5) and BPC section 152 (Failure to Pay Fine).

On or about January 19, 2023, Beaumont entered into a written contract to provide architectural drawings for a new storage building on North Eastview Drive in Stockton. The contract price was \$5,800. The contract provided a period of performance of four weeks.

Beaumont's written contract for the North Eastview Drive project failed to include required contractual terms, including a description of the procedure to accommodate additional services, a statement identifying the ownership and use of instruments of service prepared by the architect, and a statement in at least 12-point type that reads: "Architects are licensed and regulated by the California Architects Board located at 2420 Del Paso Road, Suite 105, Sacramento, CA 95834."

Beaumont failed to complete the project within four weeks. His client attempted to contact Beaumont for updates, but Beaumont failed to respond in a timely manner, often taking weeks to reply. During this time, Beaumont stated that the plans had been approved by the building department. This was untrue. His client went to the San Joaquin County

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Building Department on or about August 26, 2024, and discovered that the project had been closed because Beaumont never replied to a letter the building department issued on September 20, 2023.

On or about December 27, 2022, Beaumont entered into a written contract to provide architectural drawings to raise up an existing house, add a new first floor, and legalize an existing garage ADU conversion on Clarke Street in San Leandro. The contract price was \$10,600. The contract provided a period of performance of eight weeks.

Beaumont submitted his drawings to the San Leandro Building Department for approval. On or about October 2, 2023, the San Leandro Building Department requested further information from Beaumont regarding the permit issued for the Clarke Street Project. Beaumont ignored the San Leandro Building Department's request for information.

On or about March 6, 2024, the San Leandro Building Department followed up with Beaumont regarding the status of his submittal. On the same day Beaumont promised he would resubmit by March 8, 2024, but failed to do so. A year later, on or about March 12, 2025, the building department attempted to follow up with Beaumont on the status of the submittal but received no response. Due to

Beaumont's lack of response, the planning permit expired on or about July 3, 2024, with no possibility of extension.

The client made numerous phone calls to Beaumont but received no response.

Beaumont was previously issued Citation No. 23-17 for violations of Business and Professions Code sections 5584 (Negligence or Willful Misconduct); and 5536.22(a) (Written Contract Requirements); and California Code of Regulations, title 16, sections 150 (Willful Misconduct); and 160(c)(1) (Rules of Professional Conduct, Timely Response to the Board). Beaumont was ordered to pay a total fine of \$3,000 and was issued an Order of Abatement to cease and desist from violating Business and Professions Code sections 5584 and 5536.22(a), and California Code of Regulations, title 16, sections 150 and 160(c)(1). Beaumont has not paid the citation fine and has not ceased from violating Business and Professions Code sections 5584 and 5536.22(a), and California Code of Regulations, title 16, sections 150 and 160(c)(1).

Beaumont has been ordered to reimburse the Board's investigative costs and pay restitution. The Board's decision became effective on April 27, 2026.



Continuing Education Audit

Final Citations

CE Citations are issued to licensed architects when a violation of the continuing education, license renewal, or coursework audit requirements occurs. You may look up the code sections violated on the Board's website at www.cab.ca.gov/resrcs/act.shtml.

When a fine is levied with a citation, payment of the fine does not constitute admission of any violations, but represents a satisfactory resolution of the matter pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 125.9(d). A license shall not be renewed without full payment of any outstanding fines. All final citations are subject to public disclosure for five years.
