Amend Section 152 of Article 8 of Division 2 of Title 16 of the California Code of Regulations to read as follows:

§ 152. Citations.

* * * *

- (a) Where citations include an assessment of an administrative fine, they shall be classified according to the nature of the violation and shall indicate the classification on the face thereof as follows:
 - (1) Class "A" violations are violations which the executive officer has determined involve an unlicensed person who has violated Business and Professions Code sections 5536, 5536.1, 5536.4, orand 5536.5 of the code, orand title 16, section 134 of these regulations, including but not limited to, acting in the capacity of or engaged in the practice of architecture. A class "A" violation is subject to an administrative fine in an amount not less than seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$750) and not exceeding two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) for each and every violation, except a higher fine may be assessed when expressly authorized by statute.
